#### 2) Course Restrictions

Course Restrictions (Undergraduate)

Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, Law, Teacher Education, Cyber Defense, Art & Design, Smart Mobility, Communications Engineering and all courses at Sejong Campus are NOT AVAILABLE to exchange students.

- The courses in Business, Media & Communications, International Studies and Psychology (courses with BUSS, JMCO, DISS, PSYC) are not restricted but are in high demand.

- It is highly recommended to confirm graduation requirements at the home university, as KU's course registration operates on a first-come, first-served basis and is not guaranteed.
- KU does not guarantee any courses for exchange/visiting students. Stay flexible and have a backup plan.
- Some lab/practice courses may have TAs who teach in Korean. Contact the professor of the course in advance to confirm details.

### 3) Notes

- Courses listed under the X) column are open to exchange students.
- If you plan to take courses in English, please make sure that "(English)" is included in the official course name listed on the course registration website.
- Courses marked with "ES" are taught in Korean with English subtitles. Please note that the English subtitles are automatically generated by a program and may not be completely accurate. Before registering, please make sure that your home university will approve the course for credit transfer, even though the course is taught in Korean.
- Undergraduates (SEP) and both Undergraduates & Graduates (VSP) are allowed to take up to 19 credits per semester. These students are NOT ALLOWED to take graduate courses.

- KU uses a 4.5 GPA scale. The grading scale and credit hour value can be found [here](#).
- For credit transfer or recognition, students must contact their home university directly.
- Grades will be finalized in early January (Fall) and early July (Spring). If students have any questions or concerns about their grades, they are responsible for contacting the professor of the course directly only by the Grade Revision Period.
- Official transcripts will be sent only in English to the home university between January 15-31 (Fall) and July 15-31 (Spring).

- KU degree-seeking students must register for courses during the course registration period assigned to their current academic standing/year of study (senior, junior, sophomore or freshman).

- However, unlike KU degree-seeking students, ALL exchange and visiting students may register for courses during any of these periods listed below (1-4)). This means you may participate in all 4 course registration periods listed below (1-4)), giving you 4 opportunities to register for courses.

- KU course registration is conducted through the university's online system on a first-come, first-served basis, just like at other universities in Korea. We strongly recommend that you begin registering for your courses as soon as registration officially opens on the first day, August 11.
