

How to Find Courses and Syllabi Without a Login

- Graduate

1. Go to <https://sugang.korea.ac.kr/graduate>.
2. Select **English** (Top Left), then click Graduate Course.

Please log in and register the course after the start time of the course registration.

Notice for Registration

1. This notice is for GENERAL graduate school students.
2. Please contact each admin office of graduate school for Professional or Special graduate school course registration.
3. Access to exclusive URL for course registration, and then choose 'Graduate School' and '1st Semester' correctly.
4. Registration Period: **1. 2026-08-12(WED)13:00 ~ 08-14(FRI)12:00**
5. Note: Guidance of Research should be chosen every semester
 - > Division of Guidance of Research >
 - Current Students: DKX500-division (Title: Guidance of Research)
 - Graduate Students in Program in Biomicrosystem Engineering, and those who are in the 2nd or above semester of Science and Technology Studies : DKX510 for Research of Guidance 1, and DKX520 for Research of Guidance 2, 1 credit per each
 - Completed research graduate students: DKX-600 (Title: Tutorial Research after Completion of Course Work)
 - ※ Except for Guidance of Research credits, students who completed course works are not allowed to take other courses
 - ※ A completed research student is required to register every semester complying with the academic schedule until he or she acquires the degree.
 - 6. Graduate school has been operating 'core-curriculum' courses to strengthen graduate students' researcher literacy and capabilities.
 - [Search Course] → [Graduate Course] → Graduate Course Registration System : 2024 / Fall / Graduate School / Graduate School → Search
 - 7. [Introduction to Graduate Studies](GRAS111) is a course that meets graduation requirements (research ethics, human rights and gender equality, etc.) and the obligation to complete the semester (improving disability awareness, etc.). It is the course that cultivates the basic knowledge necessary for graduate research and helps to establish a successful academic plan by familiarizing yourself with graduate school regulations. Freshmen students are highly recommended to take this course. (It is possible to take the course even though you are not freshmen.)

Password

- Portal (KUPID) users: Use your portal password.
- Non-portal (KUPID) users: Set your password in the "Password Change for Non-Portal Users" menu on the course registration website.
 - The initial password is your date of birth [YYMMDD].
 - ※ New International Undergraduate Students (through International Undergraduate Admission ONLY) and Exchange Students (Email Notification from GSC)

If you forget your password

- Portal users: Reset your password via "Finding your Portal Password" on the portal login page (<https://portal.korea.ac.kr>).
- Non-portal (KUPID) users : Reset your password via "Password Change for Non-Portal Users" on the course registration site (<https://sugang.korea.ac.kr/graduate>).
- If you have changed or reset your password through the portal, please wait 10 minutes before logging in.
